Acceptable Items



SINGLE STREAM, NO-SORT RECYCLING IS EFFICIENT, IT SAVES TIME AND SPACE AND IT IS GOOD FOR THE ENVIRONMENT!

RECYCLE RIGHT, SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX

Include these items (rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue) in your single stream recycle bin – no sorting or bagging required.

PLASTICS

WHAT Plastics labeled #1–7 including bottles, lids, containers, take-out food containers, clamshells and trays, #5 and #6 single serve coffee pods.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



GLASS

WHAT Glass bottles and jars.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



POLYCOAT

WHAT Boxed containers for beverages and soups.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



METAL

WHAT Tin food cans, lids and beverage containers, aluminum cans and foil.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



PAPER

WHAT Newspaper, magazines, printed paper and shredded paper.

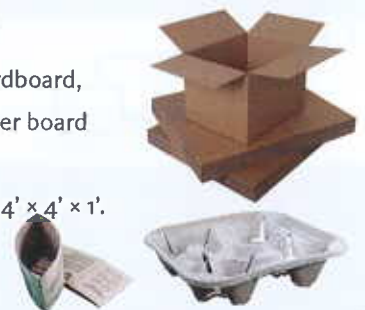
HOW Shredded paper in a clear plastic bag. This is the only item that should be bagged.



CARDBOARD

WHAT Corrugated cardboard, box board, paper board and cartons.

HOW No larger than 4' x 4' x 1'.

Not collected curbside:

Large Items



For items too large for roadside collection (e.g., mattresses, chairs, refrigerators, freezers), call: 519-287-2015 for a list of private contractors who may collect and transport such items to a landfill site at the requestor's expense.

Sharps



Many unusual and sometimes dangerous things have been found in the blue box. Hypodermic needles cause obvious concerns for those who handle blue box materials. Needles and syringes are **NOT** recyclable and should **NOT** be placed in recycling containers. Contact your local pharmacist, health unit or hospital for proper disposal.

Household Special Waste



No liquid, radioactive, volatile, highly flammable, explosive, infectious pathological, asbestos, hazardous, or construction and demolition waste or any waste which is not otherwise permitted by law.

Residents can drop off their household special waste items for free at the City of London's W12A Landfill site located at 3502 Manning Drive just south of Highway 401. For more information, visit SWM's website: www.southwestmiddlesex.ca

E-Waste



Southwest Middlesex has made arrangements to accept electronic waste at our Waste Management Transfer Station on Trillium Drive. Electronic waste consists of audio and video players, cameras, cell phones, computers, copiers, fax machines, monitors, printers, radios, receivers, scanners, telephones, televisions, etc. If you have any questions, please call the SWM office: at 519-287-2015.



Waste

These items require alternative handling.

These items are NOT accepted with your recycling.



Napkins, paper towels and food soiled cardboard – put these in your organic bin.



Textiles and other items that can be re-used.



Plastic items not labelled #1-7 or large plastic products.



Diapers and personal hygiene products.



Ceramics, glassware and houseware.



Hazardous waste, sharps and electronics.



Scrap metal, wires and cables, home and construction waste.



Organic, kitchen, yard and animal waste.

Bag Tags Program

\$1.75 each



Council will maintain the current bag system to encourage waste reduction and to meet provincial standards for waste diversion from landfill sites.

Acceptable Container Size:

30-gallon clear garbage bags weighing no more than 45 lbs (20 kg) bearing a bag tag will be collected.

Set-Out: Wrap the tag around the neck of the garbage bag and stick the two glued surfaces together to ensure that it will not come off. If garbage cans or bundles are used, the tag should be attached securely to the top piece of garbage in the can or on the bundle. Tagged household waste will not be accepted at the Transfer Station.
