

# Face Covering or Mask is Required

All persons entering or remaining in these premises shall wear a mask or face covering which covers the nose, mouth and chin as required under Southwest Middlesex By-Law 2020/048:

The following persons are exempt from the requirement to wear a Mask or Face Covering:

- Children under twelve years of age;
- Persons with an underlying medical condition or disability which inhibits their ability to wear a Face Covering;
- Persons who are unable to place or remove a Face Covering without assistance;
- Persons who are reasonably accommodated by not wearing a Face Covering in accordance with the Ontario Human Rights Code;
- Persons in an Establishment, while receiving services are permitted to temporarily remove a mask or face covering where necessary for the purpose of receiving services or while actively engaging in athletic or fitness activity.
