<u>APPLICATION INFORMATION</u> 2021 Municipal Appointment



The <u>Appointment Procedure for Filling Vacancy on Council</u> as approved by Southwest Middlesex Council will be followed.

All applicants must be a qualified elector as defined in the *Municipal Elections Act*. As of December 1, 2021 they must be:

- A Canadian citizen
- At least 18 years old, and
- Resides in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex, or is the owner or tenant of land in Southwest Middlesex, or the spouse of such an person; and
- Not prohibited from voting (as per the Municipal Elections Act) or otherwise by law.

All applicants must file the following with the Clerk:

- A completed Council Vacancy Application form (must be signed in front of a commissioner).
- A completed Council Vacancy Declaration of Qualification form (must be signed in front of a commissioner).
- Identification showing his or her name and a qualifying address to the satisfaction of the CAO-Clerk.
- Freedom of Information release form.

Note: We cannot accept faxes, e-mails or mailed-in forms.

There is no filing fee.

Applicants will be invited to address Council for no more than five minutes each at the December 1, 2021 meeting. Applicants may also submit a personal statement of qualification (similar to resume) for Council's consideration to be included in the public council agenda package. Personal statements will be typewritten in a 12-point (or greater) font on letter size (8½ "x 11") paper, shall not exceed one page in length, and will include the applicant's name and address.
