**Road Access:** All roads will have restrictions during resurfacing, only allowing local traffic to access their properties. The contractor will work with impacted properties as it relates to driveway impacts and access to property.

**Vibration – Protect Valuables:** Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

**Mail Services:** Canada post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted.

**Garbage and Recycling Collection:** If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction the Municipality & contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling.
