Purpose and Effect

The purpose and effect of Application for Consent B18-2024 is to sever a parcel of land to facilitate the disposal of a surplus farm dwelling as a result of farm consolidation. Municipally known as 22226 Tait's Road, the lands proposed to be severed would have a frontage of approximately 70 m (229.66 ft) along Tait's Road and an area of approximately 0.49 ha (1.21 ac). The lands proposed to be severed contains a single detached dwelling and one shed and is serviced by a shared well, relying on water access from 22208 Tait's Road and a private septic system. These lands have an existing access from Tait's Road.

The purpose and effect of Application for Consent B19-2024 is to sever another parcel of land to facilitate the disposal of a surplus farm dwelling as a result of farm consolidation. Municipally known as 22208 Tait's Road, the lands proposed to be severed would have a frontage of approximately 70 m (229.66 ft) along Tait's Road and an area of approximately 0.49 ha (1.21 ac). The lands proposed to be severed contains a single detached dwelling and one shed and is serviced by a shared well and private septic system. These lands have an existing access from Tait's Road.

The lands as a whole have an area of approximately 40.47 ha (100 ac) and a frontage of approximately 690 m (2,265.22 ft). The lands proposed to be retained would have a broken frontage of approximately 550 m (1,804.461 ft) along Tait's Road and an area of approximately 39.48 ha (97.58 ac). The retained lands are vacant of buildings and structures and consists of agricultural land in crop production. Confirmation of an existing access off Tait's Road or Newbiggen Drive or the establishment of a new access off Tait's Road or Newbiggen Drive will be required as a result of the severance.

The purpose and effect of Application for Consent B20-2024 is to establish a 6 m (19.68 ft) wide well easement over the subject lands, in particular, the retained lands from Application for Consent B18-2024 & B19-2024 in favour of 22208 Tait's Road, the severed lands from Application for Consent B19-2024. The well is located approximately 68 metres from the severed lot, therefore the applicant has requested a well easement approximately 68 metres in length.

A location map is attached for reference.

Description and Location of Subject Lands

The subject lands are located on the northeast corner of Tait's Road and Newbiggen Drive. The lands are legally described as South Part of Lot 20, Range 2 North, Municipality of Southwest Middlesex (Ekfrid).
