Those interested in bidding are requested to attend a mandatory meeting on site on the following date: <u>Thursday</u>, <u>November 7, 2024</u>, <u>at 10:00 a.m.</u> local time, at the Limerick Landfill, located at 724 Limerick Road, Bothwell, Ontario. <u>Bids will not be opened from any company who did not have a representative at the mandatory site meeting.</u>

The work consists of the following major items (please refer to the Tender Document Sections 1.0 and 4.0 for detailed scope of work and estimated quantities:

- 1. Clear and grub vegetation within the construction areas located within inferred limit of waste and extents of the proposed perimeter ditches.
- 2. Strip and temporarily stockpile topsoil within the construction areas.
- 3. Regrade the landfill within the inferred waste limit to the top of waste lines and grades.
- 4. Realign, regrade and construct West Ditch 1 & 2, South Ditch 1 and East Ditch 1, 2 & 3 to the lines and grades shown on the Construction Drawings.
- 5. Supply and place rip rap aprons, complete with geotextile, within the ditches. Supply and install 300 mm diameter corrugated steel pipe (CSP) culvert, complete with a 100 mm diameter orifice plate as shown on the Construction Drawings, including frost protection, bedding, cover and associated works.
- 6. Supply, place, compact and grade the 600 mm thick clayey cover soil over the re-graded top of waste or soil fill. Place and grade 150 mm thick topsoil, obtained from on-Site temporary stockpiles, over the clayey cover soil.
- 7. Remove and dispose of the gate located at the existing north entrance along Limerick Road and replace it with fence panels. Install a new access gate and access road at the existing south Site entrance along Limerick Road.
- 8. Supply and place Seed Mix #1, nurse crop, mulch and fertilizer over the topsoil located within the inferred landfill limits. Supply and place Seed Mix #2, nurse crop, mulch and fertilizer over the topsoil located within the perimeter ditches.

Each tender must be accompanied by a tender deposit in the form of a certified cheque or Bid Bond as per the tender requirements, along with a signed Agreement to Bond for 100% Performance, 50% Labour and Material Payment and Maintenance Bond.
