



Roadside Ditch Restoration and Culvert Improvement Project

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Southwest Middlesex will soon begin a roadside ditch restoration and culvert upgrade project on your road. This letter outlines key details about the project, including how it may affect you. Approved by Council on June 5, 2024, the project aims to stabilize roadside drainage ditch and extend a culvert to enhance road safety and improve the durability of municipal infrastructure

Location: Switzer Drive between McArthur Road and Thames Road

Schedule: Tentative start date – Monday, December 9, 2024 (Weather Permitting)
Estimated completion – Friday, December 20, 2024

Scope: Roadside Ditch Restoration and Culvert Upgrade.

Contractor: JLH Excavating Inc.

How will Construction Impact You?

Road Access: Switzer Drive will be closed, only allowing local traffic to access their properties. The contractor will work with impacted properties as it relates to driveway impacts and access to property.

Vibration – Protect Valuables: Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

Mail Services: Canada post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted.



Garbage and Recycling Collection: If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction the Municipality & contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling.
