

## February 5, 2025 Council Meeting Highlights

Here are some highlights from the council meeting:

- The Court of Revision approved the assessments as levied for the Stinson Drain.
- A by-law was passed to allow refreshment vehicles (food trucks) on municipal land and an agreement was signed to allow Sam Tountas to operate Rocky's Food Truck at the Glencoe train station for the 2025 season.
- The municipal land lease request for proposal was awarded for a 3-year term.
- The 2025 Budget meetings are being planned for March 2025. The public will be notified of the dates.
- Council approved the use of GrantMatch, to assist in finding suitable funding grants for municipal projects.
- The following tenders were awarded:
  - Supply of Granular Material tender to Johnston Bros. (Bothwell) Limited in the amount of \$22.79/tonne for granular "M" and \$22.79/tonne for granular "A".
  - Dust Control tender to Den-Mar Brines Limited in the amount of \$0.0816/litre.

## February 5, 2025 Council Meeting Highlights

- Council approved the signing of the Fire Protection Grant agreement which will fund the replacement of 5 sets of tradition fire fighter turnout gear.
- The municipality was successful in receiving a grant from the Community Preparedness Grant Program for the purchase of an emergency operating centre generator at the municipal office.
- The municipality received notice that its application to the Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund (HEWSF) for funding towards the Indutrial Road Sanitary Pump Station Upgrades, was unsuccessful.
- Council approved signing an agreement to extend Integrity Commissioner services currently provided by Aird & Berlis LLP for a term covering March 31, 2025 - December 31, 2027.
- Council approved the signing of an agreement with Glencoe Summer Market to operate a market during the summer months in the Glencoe train station parking lot from June - September.
